Module I: Introduction to banking (8 hours)

Commercial Banks: Meaning, Role and Functions, Types, Definition of Banking as per Banking Regulation Act1949, Banking Systems – Branch Banking Vs Unit Banking and other Banking Systems, Deposit Banking Vs Commercial Banking. Different terms used in banking

Module II: Bank as a financial institution (6 hours)

Opening of an Account, Types of Deposit Accounts, Types of Customers (individuals, firms, Trusts, and Companies), Importance of customer relations – Customer grievances and redressal. Cheques - Essentials of Valid Cheques

Module III: Banking services (10 hours)

Loans- Different types, Procedure, Criteria, Interest calculation,

Deposit- types of deposit, current, saving, fixed/term.

Bank Assurance-Investment banking, Agency services (collection of cheques, bill, draft, payment of interest, insurance premium, security sales and purchase, foreign exchange), merchant banking, lease finance, venture capital

Utility services- locker, credit-debit card- traveller cheque- internet banking, mobile banking,
